

WHY JESUS? STRAIGHT TALK FROM THE BIBLE

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that everyone who believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved." (John 3:16-17)
